Getting here and about:

Whether you prefer to travel by car, train, plane, bike or bus, choose your own adventure to explore Wollongong.

Train: The train journey from Sydney to Wollongong is iconic for a reason, with bush as far as the eye can see and priceless coastal views. Sit back and enjoy the journey, then alight at one of our local stations including Thirroul, North Wollongong and Wollongong.

Bus: Once you're here, explore Wollongong via our extensive bus network. Hop on and off the free GONG shuttle, linking the city's most popular beach, shopping and entertainment precincts.

Bike: Hire a bike or bring your own to explore cycle-friendly tracks or cruise the coastal cycle path at your own pace.

Scooter: Hire a bright orange Neuron e-scooter, available to collect from various points around the city.

Taxi/Uber: Let someone else take the wheel with the convenience of a taxi or the flexibility of an Uber.

Fly: Arrive by air into our convenient regional airport located in Albion Park Rail, with a range of domestic flight options, or take to the skies on a scenic helicopter flight.

Drive: Self-drive your way into the city via the scenic Grand Pacific Drive or the convenient M1 Princes Motorway, with our CBD just 1 hour 15 minutes from Sydney.

Visitor information: Ask the experts

Find advice on where to stay, play, eat and explore at the Wollongong Visitor Information Centre inside the Southern Gateway Centre, perched atop the Illawarra Escarpment with spectacular 180 degree views. Our friendly team can assist with bookings and recommendations, or simply grab a coffee or gelato and enjoy the view. What they don't know about Wollongong isn't worth knowing!

Beaches Life's a beach in the Gong

Whether you want to swim in a renowned rockpool or take to the waves at one of 17 patrolled beaches, in Wollongong, you're spoiled for choice. With easy parking, sparkling waters and beachside playgrounds and barbeques, the hardest part will be choosing your favourite. Here are some of our top picks:

North Wollongong Beach: A visit to Wollongong isn't complete without a trip to North 'Gong. Stroll along the Blue Mile which links the beach to the boat harbour, enjoy beachside foodie delights, take in the beautiful heritage buildings or hit the surf. This beach is patrolled all year round and has something for everyone.

Get your dose of Vitamin Sea **Thirroul Beach:** Chill at the beachfront café, hit the surf or swim some laps at the 50 metre saltwater pool, before burning off some energy at the popular playground.

Austinmer Beach: This quaint beach is popular with locals and visitors alike. Enjoy twin rock pools overlooked by the historic pavilion or relax on the golden stretch of sand and soak up the serenity.

Towradgi Beach: With prime position on the scenic coastal path, Towradgi boasts a stunning rock pool, playground and plenty of space for barbeques and picnics.



Port Kembla Beach: This southside beach has golden sand stretching as far as the eye can see, as well as the iconic Port Kembla Pool - a 50 metre saltwater pool complex with something for the whole family.

If water sports are calling, get some expert advice with surfing lessons with **Illawarra Surf Academy** or a more serene pace with **Stand Up Paddleboarding Shellharbour**.

From our nine rock pools to the expanse of Lake Illawarra to the delights of our dog-friendly beaches and the thrill of the surf break at Sandon Point, find your happy place by the water in Wollongong.

Quick tip: If you've only got a few hours to spare, head to North Beach or City Beach for cranking waves, beachside cafés, drool-worthy views and free parking (yep, you read that right).





Make every step count as you explore the natural wonders of our region's best bushwalks. To the north, hit the **Coast Track** in the **Royal National Park**, to the west explore the rainforest trails of the Illawarra Escarpment, or head east to enjoy coastal paths with endless ocean views. Better keep your camera handy.

Get your hiking boots on and your heart racing as you master the **Mount Keira Ring Track**, taking you through temperate rainforest and earning you a stunning view of the city and coastline.

The whole family can go chasing waterfalls on the boardwalk trail to **Maddens Falls** in **Dharawal National Park** near Darkes Forest, a beautiful place of great significance to the Dharawal Aboriginal people and home to a number of special Aboriginal sites. Look for birdlife, wildflowers, frogs and reptiles along the way. See our legendary coastline up close on the **Grand Pacific Walk** shared walking and cycling pathway, crossing the iconic **Sea Cliff Bridge** before taking in heritage pubs, nature reserves, beaches and charming seaside villages along the way.

Head for the heights of the **Mount Keira Summit Track** or climb the 405 steps from **Stanwell Park to Bald Hill** on the newly opened track, one of the links in the **Great Southern Walk** - a 67km multi-day walk linking Sydney's South to Bulli Tops, nearing completion.

Quick Tip: Short on time? Puckeys Estate is a rare coastal habitat with rainforest, dunes and marshland just 5 minutes from the city centre.

Lookouts Captivating vistas

Get a bird's-eye view of our beautiful city from one of the many lookouts and viewpoints, or take it to the next level from 15,000 feet above on a tandem skydive with **Skydive Australia** or a scenic flight with **Touchdown Helicopters** and enjoy a whole new perspective on Wollongong.

Start at the entry point to the South Coast Region - **the Southern Gateway Centre** - perched high on the Illawarra Escarpment at Bulli Tops. Marvel at the sweeping 180 degree views of our coastline before treating yourself to something delicious from **Gelato Emporium** or **Altitude 1148**.

At **Bald Hill,** look out over the many beaches that adorn our city, the famous **Sea Cliff Bridge** and the endless enormity of the Pacific Ocean. This is a popular spot for hang gliders and paragliders, who catch the wind and fly out over the beach at **Stanwell Park**.

Heading south you can freshen up and enjoy uninterrupted ocean views from the beautifully restored heritage hotel, **The Imperial at Clifton** or stop at **Headlands Austinmer Beach** for a coastal vista - you might even spot a whale at the right time of year. Did you know Wollongong is the only point on the east coast of Australia with two lighthouses? At **Flagstaff Hill** you can see both lighthouses against the backdrop of Wollongong Harbour and the Illawarra Escarpment, then stop by **Levendi Fish & Chippery** for lunch with a harbour view.

History buffs will love **Hill 60** at Port Kembla south of the city, a heritage-listed Aboriginal site which is also the location of a World War II installation - the Illowra Battery, with views across the surrounding beaches.

Quick tip: Start at Bald Hill and traverse Sea Cliff Bridge before winding through seaside villages, or head straight to Mt Keira Lookout to see the whole city instead. Enjoy lunch with a view at **Steamer's Bar and Grill, Wollongong Golf Club** or **Diggies**.

Embark on a culinary journey with Italian flavours at one of the local favourites - including Restaurant Santino, Kneading Ruby, or il Bene at The Fraternity Club.

Seafood is always on the menu - fresh caught and full of flavour. Savour seafood favourites at **South** Sailor, Lagoon Restaurant, Levendi Fish & Chippery, The Boathouse North Wollongong, Bombora Seafood or Harbourfront Restaurant.

Prefer your food with a view? Try Palisade Kitchen at Novotel Wollongong Northbeach, Steamers Bar and Grill, The Imperial at Clifton, Diggies and the Illawarra Yacht Club.

Heart-pumping days out: If you want to feel the fear (and do it anyway), get ready to make some adrenaline-fuelled family memories here. Don't miss Jamberoo Action Park (open Sept to April) for an amazing selection of water slides and rides, from the drop of The Stinger to the thrills of The Perfect Storm and twists and turns of The Taipan. Immerse yourself in outdoor enjoyment as you swing into Treetops Adventure Nowra for some high flying fun or rev your engines and unleash your inner speed demon at **C1 Speed Indoor Karting & Laser Tag**.

Full-on fun in any weather: Rainy day? It's all good. We've got plenty of indoor action to keep you and your tribe busy. Check out the largest Buddhist temple in NSW at **Nan Tien Temple** for a dose of tranquillity (and a delicious vegetarian feast), or keep bright sparks engaged at the **UOW Science Space**, home to interactive science displays, live shows and our very own Planetarium. Find your favourite 'wow' moment as you wander the city's streets and admire the large-scale murals that adorn our city's urban canvas thanks to the Wonderwalls art project. These jaw-dropping artworks are on a scale of their own - from multistorey facades to shopping centre walls and secret alleys. Go on an art hunt and get ready to find some hidden treasures!

Explore the extensive collections and seasonal exhibitions in the Wollongong Art Gallery, which houses a rich display of early Australian art, Aboriginal art, contemporary Australian art and international pieces inside a landmark art-deco-style building in the heart of the city.

Find something out of the ordinary at the Project Contemporary Art Space, a vibrant, inclusive multi-disciplinary art space with exhibitions, events and workshops featuring emerging, innovative and experimental artists.

Step back in time with a visit to the **HARS** Aviation Museum and explore aviation history while getting up close and personal with some seriously impressive aircraft or discover the industrial heritage of our region with a visit to **Inside Industry** for a behind-the-scenes tour of the Port Kembla Steelworks.

Quick tip: Make a night (or a matinee) of it and head to a show at the Illawarra Performing Arts Centre, Wollongong Town Hall or WIN Sports & Entertainment Centre - whether you're looking for big belly laughs, live music moments, breathtaking drama or contemporary dance, we've got you covered.

Dharawal Culture & Country

Welcome to Dharawal Country.

Get on a first name basis with our First Nations heritage as you discover the stories, art and sacred connection of the region's Aboriginal people and the local area.

This special place, where the mountains meet the sea, is rich in history, culture and storytelling that has lasted thousands of years.

Start at the Dharawal Country Experience within the Southern Gateway Centre. Here, you'll find a self-guided experience introducing you to the traditions, wisdom and culture of Dharawal country and the Wollongong (Woolyungah) region. In the learning hub, video content and audiovisual displays explain the cultural significance of the area and what Indigenous life was like here.

First Nations perspectives



Marvel at impressive First Nations artworks, and then head out to the viewing platform for 180-degree views of the area, with signage to showcase local landmarks in their Indigenous names.

Head into the city centre, and at **Wollongong Art Gallery** you'll find traditional and contemporary works by hundreds of Aboriginal artists from the local area and across the country. From here, visit Wollongong Botanic Garden to explore the Towri Bush Tucker Garden and Towri Centre, where you can learn how local native plants were used for food, medicine and shelter by Aboriginal people.

Delve deeper into the rich cultural tapestry of our region at the Coomaditchie United Aboriginal **Corporation** in Warrawong, where some of the premier Aboriginal artists in the Illawarra region display their art, capturing the spirit, colours and stories of their cultural heritage.

Immerse yourself in the Gumaraa Aboriginal **Experience**, with interactive opportunities to discover Aboriginal art, music, dance and traditions, including didgeridoo playing, painting, weaving, bush tucker tasting and Aboriginal language.

Events Escape the everyday

Love is a four-legged word, and your heart will be bursting as you watch your dog delight in the freedom of our off-leash beaches, including Little Austinmer, East Corrimal, Coniston, MM Beach, Sharkey's Beach in Coledale, and McCauley's Beach between Thirroul and Bulli.

Let them roam free at pet-friendly parks and reserves, including King George Oval in Port Kembla Proud Park in Helensburgh, Figtree Oval and Riley Park in Unanderra. Or get their tail wagging on our shared coastal path linking Wollongong's beautiful

beaches, explore 15km of track and say hi to friendly dogs and their humans along the way. Just be sure to keep your pooch on a leash!

Sea, sand & accessibility

Accessibility matters in Wollongong and we've got countless inclusive tourism experiences for every person and every ability.

Don't let the sand spoil your fun. Hit the beach with beach matting at **Austinmer** and **Thirroul** beaches (weather permitting) and free beach wheelchairs available for hire (upon request) at our accessible beaches including North Wollongong, Port Kembla, Thirroul and Austinmer.

Make a splash at accessible swimming pools and leisure centres across the region. Get your saltwater fix at Wollongong Continental Pool with ramp and hoist access, or Port Kembla Pool which also has ramp access. Away from the coast, our chlorinated pools at Dapto, Berkeley, Helensburgh, Corrimal, Western Suburbs (Unanderra) and Beaton Park Leisure Centre offer lift platforms and/or hoist access, as well as accessible parking, shower, toilet and change-room facilities.

There'll be smiles all round at our accessible playgrounds, including the all abilities playground at Wollongong Botanic Garden, Luke's Place in Corrimal, Thirroul playground, Stuart Park playground and Cringila Hills playground, which all feature accessible equipment and toilet facilities.

Sydney

Your adventure starts here - and by here we mean the Royal National Park

Stop 1 - Royal National Park

Just 45 minutes drive south of Sydney's CBD, The Royal National Park is your first destination on the Grand Pacific Drive.

It's over 100 years old (the 2nd oldest in the world in fact) and boasts over 100km of bush walking tracks, set on 16,000 hectares. Experience nature amongst lush rainforests, stunning beaches, gorgeous picnic grounds and much more! The Royal National Park features a multitude of landscapes from open grasslands to dramatic cliffs and secluded beaches that are definitely worth the walk. As you'd expect the scenery is sublime and everyone is catered for - from accessible short strolls through to a two-day excursion for the super keen. Head south along Lady Wakehurst Drive to exit the Royal National Park and you will emerge at Bald Hill Lookout, Stanwell Tops. Take a detour to Helensburgh for Symbio Wildlife Park and hand feed free roaming Kangaroos and cuddle up to Koala's. Following Symbio take the 1st exit onto the Princes Hwy towards Darkes Forest to tastes the world's best cider at Darkes Glenbernie Orchard.

Stop 2 - Stanwell Park

Stanwell Park is the first of several pretty coastal towns south of the Royal National Park, on Lawrence Hargrave Drive.

It's a popular beach for surfing and picnics and an easy day trip from Sydney. Stanwell Park and Stanwell Tops have a special place in aviation history with Lawrence Hargrave performing many of his experiments with box kites in this location. The Grand Pacific Drive passes through Stanwell Park on its spectacular route along the coast to the South Coast. Stop at Sea Cliff Bridge, located between Coalcliff and Clifton, for a walk along this engineering masterpiece. Rest your head at Headlands Austinmer Beach, camp at Coledale Beach or Bulli Tourist Park and enjoy dinner at South Sailor in Thirroul or Resin Brewery in Bulli.

Stop 3 - Wollongong

Nestled between the mountains and the sea, Wollongong is a vibrant and unique destination for enjoying the great outdoors.

Whether you're exploring the coast or the escarpment, spectacular loft lookouts, sea level rockpools or botanic gardens, the perfect adventure is always within easy reach. Wollongong Harbour is a fantastic family friendly area that's great for paddling toddlers and laidback gatherings. It's here between the two lighthouses that you'll find plenty of picnic facilities, restaurants, cafés and playgrounds all within close proximity. Take a stroll along the Blue Mile or a dip in the Continental Pools. Head south onto Five Islands Road and continue to Bass Point Tourist Road to Bushrangers Bay Aquatic Reserve.

Stop 4 - Shellharbour

20 minutes south of Wollongong, Shellharbour is a beautiful seaside destination with exceptional natural and built attractions.
